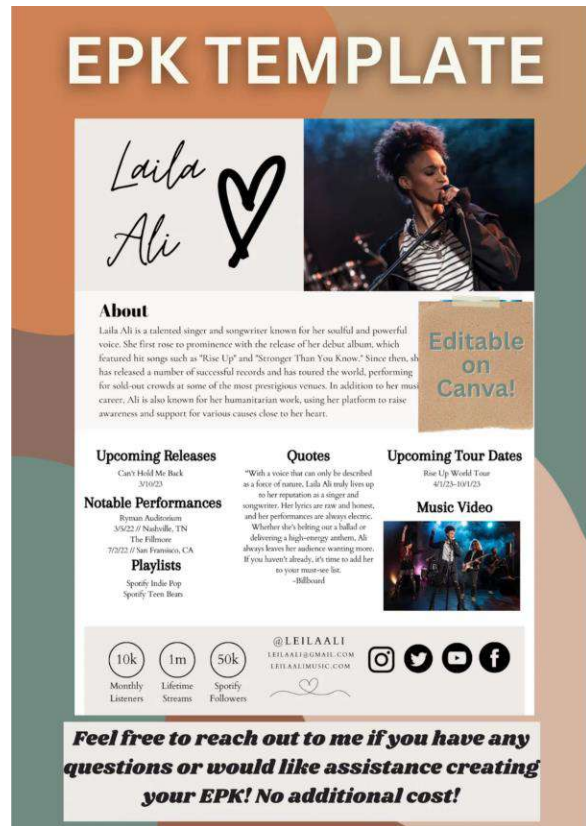

-  **Tour Dates/Performance History:** Past and upcoming shows
-  **Contact Information:** Clear details for you and your team
-  **Social Media Links:** Direct links to all active platforms

Key Visual Elements:

- **Professional Photography:**
Invest in high-quality, well-lit images that reflect your artistic identity
- **Consistent Aesthetic:**
Maintain visual cohesion across all portfolio elements
- **Multiple Formats:**
Provide both landscape and portrait orientations for media use
- **Clean Layout:**
Organize visual elements with ample white space for easy viewing

Squarespace

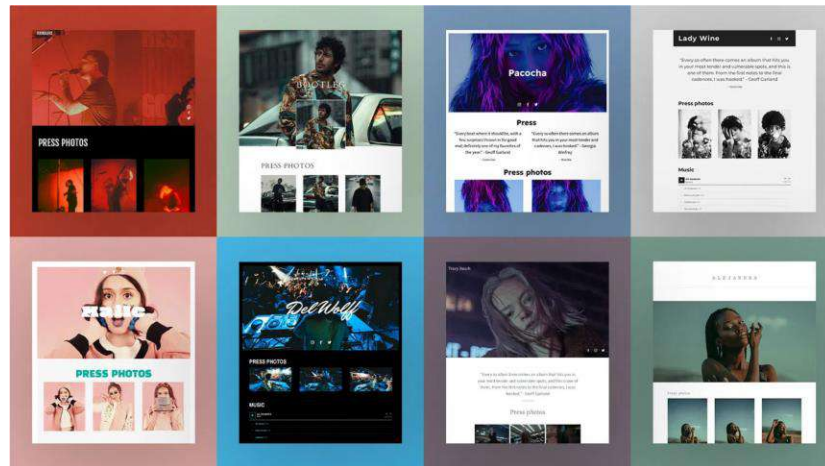
- + Professional templates designed for creatives

Dedicated EPK Services

- + Specifically designed for musicians and performers
- + Industry-standard formats and features
- May lack visual customization options



Musician-Specific EPK Elements

Essential Components for Musicians

Discography

Showcase your releases with album artwork, release dates, and streaming links. Include both singles and full-length projects.

Audio Samples

Provide 3-5 of your strongest tracks in high-quality formats with both streaming links and downloadable files.

Technical Rider

Detail your stage setup, equipment requirements, and sound preferences with a stage plot diagram.

Tour History

List notable venues, festivals, and tours, highlighting sold-out shows or supporting roles for established acts.

Consistent branding creates **instant recognition** and builds a cohesive professional image across all platforms and materials.

Key Branding Elements:

Visual Identity

Consistent color palette, typography, and design elements that reflect your artistic style

Logo & Graphics

Professional logo and graphics that work across all platforms and sizes

Tone & Messaging

Consistent voice in all written materials that aligns with your artistic identity

Cross-Platform Consistency

Unified look and feel across website, EPK, social media, and merchandise



Common Mistakes to Avoid

Pitfalls That Can Undermine Your EPK

- ✖ **Outdated Information:** Old bios, broken links, and outdated tour dates signal a lack of professionalism
- ✖ **Poor Quality Assets:** Low-resolution photos, grainy videos, or poorly recorded audio are immediate red flags
- ✖ **Overloading with Content:** Too much information overwhelms industry professionals who have limited time
- ✖ **Lack of Clear Call to Action:** Make it obvious what you want the recipient to do after viewing your EPK
- ✖ **Difficult Navigation:** Ensure your EPK is intuitive, mobile-friendly, and loads quickly
- ✖ **Generic Content:** Avoid templated material that doesn't reflect your unique artistic voice

- 🔗 Backlinking Strategy:** Secure links from reputable industry websites, blogs, and directories to boost your authority
- 📱 Mobile Responsiveness:** Ensure your portfolio works flawlessly on all devices, especially mobile
- 🌐 Social Media Integration:** Connect your portfolio to your social platforms for increased visibility and engagement
- ✍️ Regular Content Updates:** Frequently add new work and updates to signal relevance to search engines

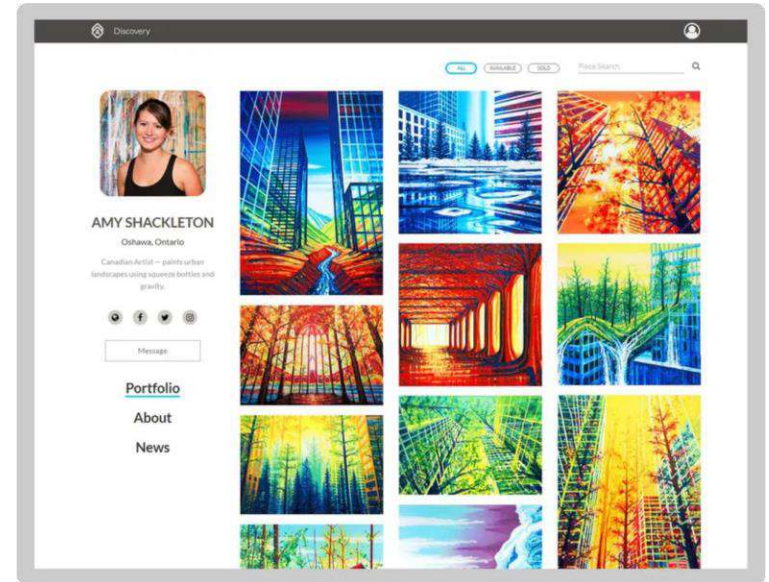
